Airport Bypass Road, Gandhi Nagar, Bhopal- 462033 for continuing BHMS course with intake capacity of 100 seats and for Post Graduate Course (MD) with intake capacity of total 21 seats in 07 subjects namely 03 seats in Homoeopathic Pharmacy, 03 seats Organon of Medicine, 03 seats in Repertory, 03 seats in Homoeopathic Materia Medica, 03 seats in Practice of Medicine, 03 seats in Paediatrics and 03 seats in Psychiatry for the academic year 2025-26 - regd.

Sir,

Ram Krishna College of Homoeopathy & Medical Science is functional since 2016 and has applied for permission for sanction of BHMS course with intake capacity of 100 seats and for Post Graduate Course (MD) with intake capacity of total 21 seats in 07 subjects namely 03 seats in Homoeopathic Pharmacy, 03 seats Organon of Medicine, 03 seats in Repertory, 03 seats in Homoeopathic Materia Medica, 03 seats in Practice of Medicine, 03 seats in Paediatrics and 03 seats in Psychiatry for the academic year 2025-26. The college has submitted Part I information in which the entire functional profile has been narrated. MARBH conducted inspection on 16.05.2025 & 17.05.2025. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board has examined the College as to whether the college fulfils the Minimum Essential Standards as per the prevailing regulations under clauses 26 & 28 of the NCH Act 2020. On careful examination of the report, the Medical Assessment and Rating Board observed the following shortfalls:

1. Deficiency of Teaching Faculty: (2 deficiencies)

- i. In Department of **Practice of Medicine**- One Assistant Professor is not available.
- ii. In Department of **Community Medicine**- One Assistant Professor is not available.
- iii. Dr. Kundan Bagde appointed as Assistant Professor in Department of Practice of Medicine, but his degree is not included in **Medical Qualification Recognition List of NCH**.
- iv. Dr. Asif Khan appointed as Assistant Professor in Department of Community Medicine, but his degree is not included in **Medical Qualification Recognition List of NCH**.

As evident from the above statement, a total number of two teachers are deficient against the requirement of 40+1 for 100 seats UG college and for Post Graduate Course (MD) with intake capacity of total 21 seats in 07 subjects namely 03 seats in Homoeopathic Pharmacy, 03 seats Organon of Medicine, 03 seats in Repertory, 03 seats in Homoeopathic Materia Medica, 03 seats in Practice of Medicine, 03 seats in Paediatrics and 03 seats in Psychiatry (As specified in MES,2024). Pursuant to F.No. :3-2/MARBH/NCH/2025-26/162-169 dtd. 16/04/2025 issued by MARBH, a college can avail 10% relaxation against the required number of teachers for Academic Year 2025-26 only. After allowing relaxation of 10%,


college doesn't have deficiency in teaching staff. However, such relaxed teachers should also be appointed at the earliest for smooth conduct of course.

2. Miscellaneous:

- i. NABH accreditation of hospital is not available.
 - ii. NABL accreditation for laboratory is not available.
 - iii. Details of practicing consultant as visiting faculty of Modern Medicine or Homoeopathy are not available.
 - iv. Separate bank statement of college is not available.
 - v. Credentials of modern medical consultants are not available for verification.
3. Considering the above observation during inspection, MARBH has decided to issue **Conditional Permission to Ram Krishna College of Homoeopathy & Medical Science, RKDF, University Campus, Nr. Airport Bypass Road, Gandhi Nagar, Bhopal- 462033 for continuing BHMS course with intake capacity of 100 seats and for Post Graduate Course (MD) with intake capacity of total 21 seats in 07 subjects namely 03 seats in Homoeopathic Pharmacy, 03 seats Organon of Medicine, 03 seats in Repertory, 03 seats in Homoeopathic Materia Medica, 03 seats in Practice of Medicine, 03 seats in Paediatrics and 03 seats in Psychiatry for the academic year 2025-26** on the basis of following conditions:-
- i. College should provide degree of Dr. Kundan Bagde & Dr. Asif Khan included in **Medical Qualification Recognition List of NCH** within one month of issue of letter.
 - ii. College should apply for NABH & NABL within one month of issue of letter.
 - iii. College should provide Credentials of modern medical consultants for verification within one month of issue of letter.
 - iv. College should submit separate bank statement of college within one month of issue of letter.
4. All admissions shall be made from NEET/AIAPGET qualified candidates only. It is further informed that minimum 15% of undergraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity of 100 UG seats & 21 seats of PG course shall be treated as All India Quota. Counseling for seats under all India quotas shall be conducted by respective Counseling Authority of State/UT govt as designated by Central Government and counseling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned counseling authority of the state/UT.
5. The Category wise list of the selected candidates may be informed to the Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Homoeopathy after the process of admission is completed. Any admissions carried out other than NEET/AIAPGET qualified students will not be approved by the Medical Assessment and Rating Board.
6. Conditions under point 3 should be fulfilled within a period of one month and the compliance report shall be submitted for verification to the office, failing which permission for the academic year 2025-26 may be withdrawn.
