Sub: Permission matter to open/Start a new Higher MD (Hom) course 70 seats in the 7 subjects with 10 seats in Materia Medica, Homoeopathic Pharmacy, Repertory, Practice of Medicine, Organon of Medicine, Pediatric and Psychiatry under section 29 of NCH Act 2020- regarding

Sir,

As per provision in the Act, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Homoeopathy has been constituted with the mandate to grant permission to the existing and new or new higher MD (Hom) medical institution of Homoeopathy. Accordingly, it is to inform you that all the relevant documents submitted by your college for new application of new PG course, were examined by the Medical Assessment and Rating Board. Further the college has been inspected by inspectors dated 2/05/2023 and after examining the inspection report, the college has been given an opportunity of physical hearing dated 15/06/2023. On examining the hearing report, it has been observed that the college were having deficiencies which are fundamental in nature and MARB has issued the denial of LOI dated-24/06/2023. Further, the college has made an appeal to commission dated 18/07/2023 and commission has given opportunity of physical hearing dated 15/09/2023. Accordingly it has been recommended by commission that the college shall be permitted to start MD (Hom) course with 21 seats in 7 subjects with 03 seats each in Materia Medica, Homoeopathic Pharmacy, Repertory, Practice of Medicine, Organon of Medicine, Pediatric and Psychiatry as per the regulations.

After considering the provisions of section 29 of NCH Act 2020 and its relevant Regulations, **Medical Assessment and Rating Board has decided to grant permission to start new MD (Hom) courses with 21 seats in 7 subjects with 03 seats each in Materia Medica, Homoeopathic Pharmacy, Repertory, Practice of Medicine, Organon of Medicine, Pediatric and Psychiatry at Ram Krishna College of Homoeopathy and Medical sciences, RKDF University Campus Airport Bypass Road, Gandhi Nagar, Bhopal, Madhya Pradesh-462033, for the academic year 2023-24.**

The college has to comply with the full requirements of NCH Act 2020 and its relevant Regulations for conducting the course. The college need to take at most steps to improve the OPD and IPD attendance and all patient records in OPD and IPD shall be complete in all respects and teaching faculties in place shall be submitted by the college to Medical Assessment and Rating Board accordingly. Subsequently, the Board shall verify the compliance well in time and may conduct Online/Physical inspection for verification of compliance as per the relevant Regulations under NCH Act 2020 and ensure that the college performs as per the prevailing Minimum Standard Requirement as per the NCH Act.

The Principal is directed to submit an affidavit in this regard to the Medical Assessment Board, within a period of one week failing which, the permission will be withdrawn without further notice.

All admissions in Under Graduate/Post graduate course shall be through AIAPGET only. It is further informed that, minimum 15% of seats of the permitted intake capacity of BHMS course shall be treated as All India quota. The counseling for seats under All India quota shall be conducted by respective counseling Authority of State / UT Government as designated by the Central Government and counseling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned counseling Authority of that State / UT. The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction of the Central Government for All India quota or the student admitted thereunder.


The category wise list of selected candidates may be informed to the Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Homoeopathy after the process of admission is completed. Any admissions carried out other than AIAPGET qualified students will not be approved by the Medical Assessment and Rating Board as per rules.
